A unified voice of all organisations dedicated to respiratory health will be a powerful force.

World Lung Day falls right before two historic events: the United Nations High-Level Meeting on Tuberculosis (26 Sept.) and the UN High-Level Meeting on Non-NCDs (27 Sept). Many of us are working hard to have these days highlight the terrible burden of lung disease and to make a difference.

Too often we take breathing for granted. World Lung Day provides an advocacy platform for people affected by and working against respiratory disease around the world.
