It focused on coalition building, multi-sectoral engagement, health systems strengthening, accountability and meaningful involvement of people living with NCDs. The programme's in-country activities were led by CSOs that developed networks for coordinated action on NCDs – Brazil's ACT Health Promotion, the Caribbean's Healthy Caribbean Coalition<sup>1</sup>, the South African NCDs Alliance (SANCDAs), and India's Healthy India Alliance (HIA).

This report serves as a resource for stakeholders interested in supporting and strengthening civil society efforts in the NCD space. It supports NCD stakeholders in making the case for coalition building and capacity development of civil society to accelerate action on NCDs.
