The 60<sup>th</sup> Session of the Commission on the Status of Women (CSW60) will be held from 14 – 24 March at UN Headquarters in New York. This year's priority theme is *Women's empowerment and its link to sustainable development*, and the review theme is *The elimination and prevention of all forms of violence against women and girls*.
