- **Time to Lead videos**: This year, we had the invaluable support of Key Opinion Leaders to call on government to Act on NCDs reminding them it's Time to Lead. These videos were shared on social media as part of the online strategy.
- Short Films: To kick-off the week, the NCD Alliance launched two short films spotlighting the impactful stories of local leaders advocating for better NCD care in their communities, <u>Raise Your Voice</u> [2] from Malawi and <u>Going Full Circle</u> [3] from India.
- **Member engagement**: In the campaign's first phase, we featured a range of insightful, member-authored blogs. Members also organised a range of impactful in-person events, conferences, and webinars, and launched reports—all contributing to the momentum that brought us to this year's Global Week for Action.
- Partners in the spotlight: The Global Week for Action on NCDs is made possible through the steadfast support of our Campaign Partners and the active involvement of the NCD Alliance Supporters Group.
- The Call to Lead on NCDs: Addressed to world leaders, The Call to Lead on NCDs plays a crucial advocacy role in the campaign, urging all governments to fulfil their commitments to address the burden of NCDs. It calls on Member States to take decisive action at the Fourth UN High-Level Meeting on NCDs in September 2025, and will be delivered to world leaders ahead of the gathering.

This campaign would not be possible without the continuous support of the NCD community, demonstrating that we can achieve greatness when we come together with a shared goal. Thanks to the dedication of national alliances, community groups, and advocates worldwide, this year's Global Week for Action on NCDs has set the stage for a transformative journey towards a healthier, more equitable world.
