The NCD Café sessions began on Wednesday with a packed out discussion on health in post 2015, and the essential need to invest in NCDs in order to secure a healthy future for all.

Since then, the NCD Café has seen a dynamic discussion led by WHO and NGO representatives on the need for a multisectoral approach in order to effectively tackle NCDs, and the urgency yet necessary thoughtful consideration of implementing such an approach.

Recommendations straight from leaders in global, regional, and national advocacy with specific reference to the Caribbean, Uganda and Australia were heard at a session on focussing on lessons learned in strengthening the civil society movement.

Two dedicated networking sessions have provided opportunities to meet the experts, maximising opportunities for individual in depth dialogue and knowledge exchange.
