World's leading lung societies unite to call for improvements in healthcare



The Forum of International Respiratory Societies (FIRS) has recently launched a report on World COPD Day entitled Respiratory diseases in the world. Realities of Today – Opportunities for Tomorrow. [1]

The report features five major disease areas, including COPD, which is the fourth leading cause worldwide. It also includes 10 key recommendations that FIRS considers to be essential to help reduce the burden of COPD and all respiratory diseases.
